

Double Major Application Requirements

- 1) Application requirements for the double major program and the required documents are announced by the OİDB.
- 2) Applications must be submitted to the OİDB by the deadline specified in the academic calendar.
- 3) A student may apply to more than one double major and/or minor program at the same time by placing their preferences in order.
- 4) Öğrencinin çift anadal programına başvurusunun geçerli olabilmesi için aşağıda belirtilen koşulları sağlaması gerekir:
 - a) Must have received at least a C or S grade in all courses taken in the major undergraduate program up to the semester of application and have a GPA of at least 3.20,
 - b) The student must be in the top 20% of the class in which he/she is registered, and for those who do not meet this requirement, he/she must have a score not less than the base score of the relevant year for the program in which he/she will pursue a double major,
 - c) The student must be enrolled in the major undergraduate program at the earliest at the beginning of the third semester and at the latest at the beginning of the fifth semester,
 - d) Additional conditions to the application and evaluation conditions specified in this guideline may be determined upon the recommendation of the relevant department and the decision of the Board of Directors and will be stated in the announcement.
- 5) Courses that have been withdrawn (received a W grade) are considered as untaken courses.

Minor Application Requirements

- 1) Application requirements for the minor program and the required documents for application are announced by the OİDB.
- 2) Applications must be submitted to the OİDB by the deadline specified in the academic calendar.
- 3) A student may apply to more than one double major and/or minor program at the same time by placing their preferences in order.
- 4) In order for the student's application to the minor program to be valid, the following conditions must be met:
 - a) Must be successful in all courses taken in the major undergraduate program up to the semester of application and have a GPA of at least 2.75,
 - b) The student must be at the beginning of the third semester at the earliest and at the beginning of the sixth semester at the latest, starting from the first semester of enrollment in the major undergraduate program,
 - c) Additional conditions to the application conditions specified in this guideline may be determined by the recommendation of the relevant department and the decision of the Board of Directors and will be included in the announcement.
- 5) Courses that have been withdrawn (received a W grade) are considered as untaken courses.
