

Lateral Transfer Between In-House Programs (Application Conditions)

1- Students who will apply for the in-house quota must meet the following conditions.

- a) The student must be enrolled in a diploma program or on leave (with student status) at the time of application.
- b) The student must have started the undergraduate program and completed at least two semesters.
- c) For internal lateral transfer applications, students must have taken at least 70% of the courses they are required to take in the semesters they have completed in their programs and must have passed these courses with at least a D/S or equivalent grade. At least one of these courses must be taken with the code of the relevant program. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)
- ç) The student's GPA must be at least 2.30/4.00.
- d) In intra-institutional lateral transfer applications, the central placement score received by the student in the type of score valid for the diploma program he wants to pass as of the year in which he took the central exam is required to be not less than the lowest base score of the diploma programs of other universities in the country equivalent to the diploma program he wants to pass.

Domestic/Interinstitutional Lateral Transfer (Application Conditions)

1- In this context, students who will apply must meet the following conditions in order to apply.

- a) It is mandatory for the student to have completed at least two semesters in his/her program (other than the English preparatory class).
 - b) The student's GPA must be at least 3.30/4.00. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)
 - c) It is mandatory for the student to have taken all the courses specified in the curriculum of the program for the semesters completed in the program in which the student is registered and to have passed with a D/S or equivalent grade. Applications of students who have not taken all the courses in the program curriculum during the semesters of registration or who have failed any course (F, NA, U, I, W or equivalent) will not be evaluated.
- 2) T.C. studying at higher education institutions in the country and KKTC nationals can apply. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)
- 3) Applications for lateral transfer to only one program can be made.
- 4) The student's placement score in the year of registration to the higher education institution must be equal to or higher than the base score of the relevant year of the program to which he/she wants to lateral transfer. (Added by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)

Lateral Transfer with Central Placement Score (Application Conditions)

- 1- In order for candidates to apply in this context, their central placement score in the year they registered to the higher education institution must be equal to or higher than the placement base score of the same year of the program they want to transfer to.
- 2) This quota is included in the YKS Guide; Candidates who have registered to higher education institutions in our country and KKTC through central placement or based on the relevant year's ÖSYS/YKS Score and special talent exam, and candidates who have registered to higher education institutions abroad through central placement by ÖSYM can apply. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)
- 3) If the student was not accepted to the program he/she wants to transfer to in the year the student registered to the program he/she is currently studying, transfer cannot be made since the central placement base score of the diploma program has not been formed.
- 4) A transfer application using the central placement score can only be submitted once.
- 5) Students who transfer to other universities with their central placement score can return at later lateral transfer application dates.
- 6) According to Article 1 of the Higher Education Council's Annex, students who cannot meet the foreign language requirement sought by our University and who have not previously completed two years of preparatory class education may transfer from a Turkish-language program (for example, from the Business Administration (Turkish) program to the Business Administration (English) program) to a program of the same name that is taught entirely or partially in a foreign language, no later than before starting their second year of education. These students can take foreign language preparatory courses, but those who have previously completed one year of preparatory class training can only take a maximum of one year of preparatory class training.

Lateral Transfer from Overseas Higher Education Institutions (Application Conditions)

- 1- In this context, candidates who will apply must meet the following conditions in order to apply. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)
 - a) It is required that the higher education institution and the program in which the candidates study abroad are recognized by YÖK, and the diploma program in which they are registered must be accepted by the relevant department where the application is made for the equivalence of the undergraduate diploma programs they apply for lateral transfer.
 - b) The student must have been accepted to AGU undergraduate programs with the SAT, which is included in the international student admission criteria, for the year in which the student entered the program he/she is enrolled in, or must have provided the YKS score for the year in which he/she entered.
 - c) The overall GPA is required to be at least 3.30/4.00.
- 2) In lateral transfer from higher education institutions abroad, students who have the base score for student admission to the relevant class of the diploma program to which the student wants to

transfer can apply for lateral transfer without requiring success in all courses taken in higher education abroad. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2025.40.04 dated 17.12.2025.)

3) For transfers from higher education institutions abroad, students must have the SAT score required for admission to the relevant class of the diploma program they wish to transfer to, and must have completed all courses specified in the curriculum of their current program for the semesters they have finished, receiving a D/S or equivalent grade. (Added by Senate Decision No. 2025.40.04 dated 17.12.2025)

4) In lateral transfer from higher education institutions abroad, the number of students who can transfer to each class of a program from the same higher education institution abroad cannot exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the international quota of the relevant class of that program. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2025.40.04 dated 17.12.2025.)

5) To be eligible for a lateral transfer to a program requiring a specific academic ranking, the student must have been ranked within the top 400 in at least three of the ranking organizations approved by the Council of Higher Education (Times Higher Education (THE), QS World University Rankings, Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), CWTS Leiden Ranking) in the year they began their higher education, and must meet the semester/class and academic performance requirements of this Regulation. The priority of the ranking organizations is determined by the Senate. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)

6) If registered at a university outside the top four hundred; (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)

a) Those who completed their secondary education in Turkey must, in any case, have taken the YKS placement exam and have met the success ranking requirement in the relevant score type of the program for which the success ranking requirement is required as of the registration year.

b) Those who have completed at least the last two years of their secondary education abroad are required to have successfully completed at least four semesters of the diploma program they are enrolled in, excluding the preparatory class.

Lateral Transfer for International Students Registered at AGU (Application Conditions)

1- International students enrolled in a program at AGU can transfer to another program depending on their SAT total score and GPA.

2) In this context, candidates who will apply must meet the following conditions:

a) In lateral transfer applications based on SAT total score, if the program to which the application is made does not have a SAT base score in the relevant year, the SAT base score is taken as 1100 in the evaluation. (Amended by Senate Decision No. 2023.24.01 dated 23.08.2023.)

b) Depending on the GPA, the GPA must be at least 2.30/4.00 for lateral transfer applications.

c) The student must be registered in a program or on leave (with student status) at the time of application.

ç) For lateral transfer applications based on SAT total score, it is mandatory to complete at least one semester in the program (other than the English preparatory class), and for lateral transfer

applications based on GPA, it is mandatory to complete at least two semesters in the program (except the English preparatory class).

d) In lateral transfer applications based on GPA, students must have taken at least 70% of the required courses in the semesters they completed in their program and passed with at least a D/S or equivalent grade. At least one of these courses must be opened with the code of the relevant program.
